EXPLANATION OF BENEFITS

Participate in Research Task Groups

Any individual from a contributing organization can volunteer to help structure the parameters of Fuels Institute research and provide guidance to facilitate completion of research projects.

Participate in Board of Advisors Deliberations

Any individual can from a contributing organization can attend in-person Board meetings and provide input to the Board of Advisors at those meetings or in advance through a formal process.

Participate in Fuels Institute Committees

Any individual from a contributing organization can serve on any or all of the Fuels Institute committees, which include Vehicles and Mobility, Fuels and Infrastructure and Global Markets

Contributor-Only Webinars

Any individual from a contributing organization can attend any of the six annual webinars hosted by the Fuels Institute.

Discounted FI Speaker Fee

The Fuels Institute speaker fee is discounted from \$5,000 to \$2,000 for presentations at events for contributing organizations.

Content for Contributor's Publications

The Fuels Institute will provide written content on relevant subjects to be included in publications distributed by contributing organizations.

Eligibility to Serve on Board of Advisors

Gold and Platinum contributors are eligible to serve on the Fuels Institute Board of Advisors, subject to seat availability, nomination and election.

Exclusive Webinars with Subject Matter Experts

The Fuels Institute will invite individuals from its Gold and Platinum contributor organizations to participate in special webinars featuring external subject matter experts.

Discount for Fuel Quality Council

The Fuel Quality Council is a separate initiative of the Fuels Institute focused on diesel fuel quality and performance of diesel engines. The market rate for serving on the Steering Committee is \$10,000.

Special Presentation or Customized Workshop

Platinum contributing organizations may schedule either a two-hour exclusive Special Presentation or a half-day Customized Workshop to be convened at their location.

Exclusive Lunch with Experts at FUELS2019

Individuals from Platinum contributing companies will be invited to have lunch with key speakers or featured experts during the Fuels Institute annual meeting, FUELS2019.
